Library	Policy
Adams State University	does not allow Prospector requests on new items for 6 months.
Arapahoe Libraries	doesn't take any steps to prevent Prospector requests on new items.
Auraria Library	does allow Prospector request on new items.
Aurora Public Library	loans items via Prospector after 6 months of the item creation date.
Boulder Public Library	do not have any restrictions on our new materials.
Bud Werner Memorial Library (Steamboat Springs)	does allow Prospector requests on new items.
CMC Glenwood Springs (Quigley Library)	keeps new books out of Prospector for two weeks; new movies are not circulated for about 3 months.
Colorado Christian University	lends new items right away.
Colorado College--Tutt Library	does allow Prospector requests on new materials.
Colorado Mesa University	does allow Prospector requests on new materials.
Colorado Mtn. College--Steamboat	does not allow anyone except for CMC patrons to request new items for the first three months.
Colorado State Library	allows prospector requests on new materials.
Colorado State University	does not have any restrictions on new items.
Colorado State University--Pueblo	lend new items.
CU Law	allows Prospector requests on new items.
Denver Public Library	allows requests on available items. Since new, popular materials are usually checked out with hold lists, they end up not being available.
Eagle Valley Library District	do not lend new adult items for three months.
Fort Lewis College--Reed Library	does not lend new items for 6 months.
Grand County Libraries	does not allow out-of-county holds for new items for the first 3 months.
Gunnison Library District	does not allow Prospector requests on new items for 6 months.
Gunnison Public Library	does not allow Prospector requests on new items for 6 months.
Jefferson County Libraries	allows Prospector requests on new items.
Longmont Public Library	does not have any restrictions on new items.
Louisville Public Library	does not have any restrictions on new items.
Loveland Public Library	does not restrict new items as of now.
Mesa County Libraries	do not take any steps to prevent Prospector requests on new items, either.
Poudre River Public Library	does allow Prospector requests on new materials.
